Goals of the Dancers Workshop:

To share our love of dance with the community

To increase people's awareness of and appreciation for creative and expressive dance

To dance amongst a group of friends who respect and admire each other's unique ways of moving

Class/Rehearsal

*Scheduled to meet Thursdays, from 5:30-6:25pm at the Stow Town Hall. In addition to attending rehearsals, dancers are required to attend a dance class at their age level.

*Perfect attendance is mandatory for members. Rehearsals are like putting together a jigsaw puzzle – if one piece is missing, it is much more difficult to assemble the others and the picture is different. Therefore, to ensure a positive feeling of support and community within the group, **students who miss more than 2 rehearsals in a session will be given an appropriately simplified part in the production.** If a dancer is sick or unable to attend rehearsal please show courtesy by calling in advance so the rehearsal can be planned accordingly.

Dancers Workshop Membership Fees

*Dancers Workshop Membership Fees are \$192 for the 2018 Fall session of dance (September-January). This fee includes all rehearsals and performing costs. Class tuition is NOT included. Please see complete schedule of classes for individual class tuition. (Please note, this is a discounted rate for students of the Creative Dance Center. Dancers who attend a weekly class at a different studio are welcome to be a part of the Dancers Workshop; however there is an additional \$30 fee.)

Costumes

*Most costumes, other than leotards, pants, and tights, will be provided by me and will remain the property of the Creative Dance Center. Occasionally an additional costume fee will be requested.

Registration

*To register please complete the Dancers Workshop Contract and Registration/Release form and return along with non-refundable registration fee of \$25 no later than August 1 so I can plan on the number of dancers. This gives me time to choreograph dances before rehearsals begin. Workshop fees and class tuition will be due in full before the start of the session. Pay in full by August 1 and receive a \$10 discount from total for early payment. All forms/fees can be made payable to Jennifer McGowan, 130 Jewett Street, Pepperell, MA 01463. (No refunds will be given after the start of the session except in the case of injuries and family emergencies.)

Start of Classes

*Rehearsals begin 30, 2018. On August 30th, the Junior Dancers Workshop will rehearse from 4:30-7:00pm and the Teen/Tween Dancers Workshop will rehearse from 5:00-7:30pm. It is important that dancers attend this first rehearsal as this is when choreography will be set for individual dancers. Also, we have been having a little potluck to celebrate the start of the new dance year!
